

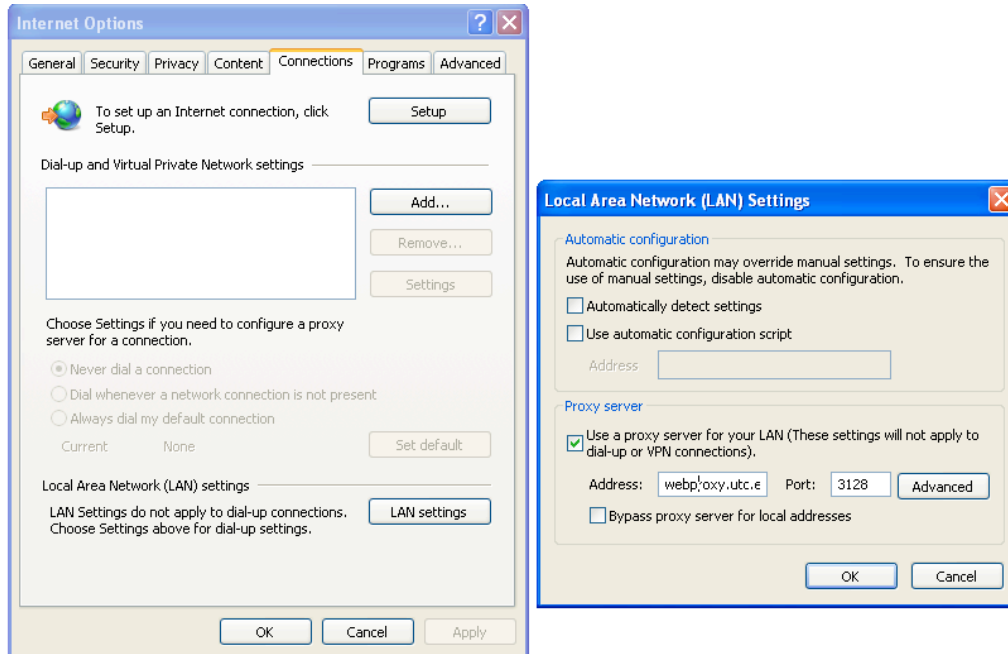
Using UTC's Web Proxy

To improve the security of web surfers on UTC's campus, users are advised to configure their browsers to use webproxy.utc.edu. Laptop, and other mobile users, should not configure their browsers to use webproxy, as it is not available off-campus.

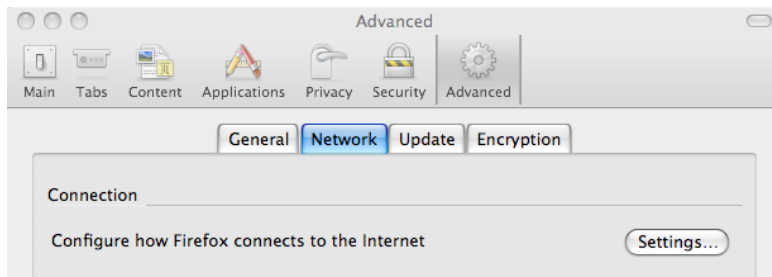
To Configure Internet Explorer

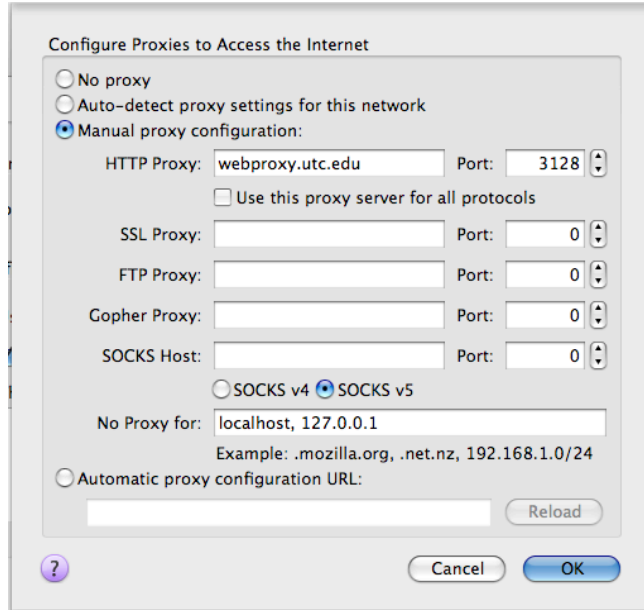
Run Internet Explorer and Select Options from the Tools Menu. Click on Connections, then LAN settings. Click the checkbox for proxy server and enter "webproxy.utc.edu" and "3128"



To Configure Firefox

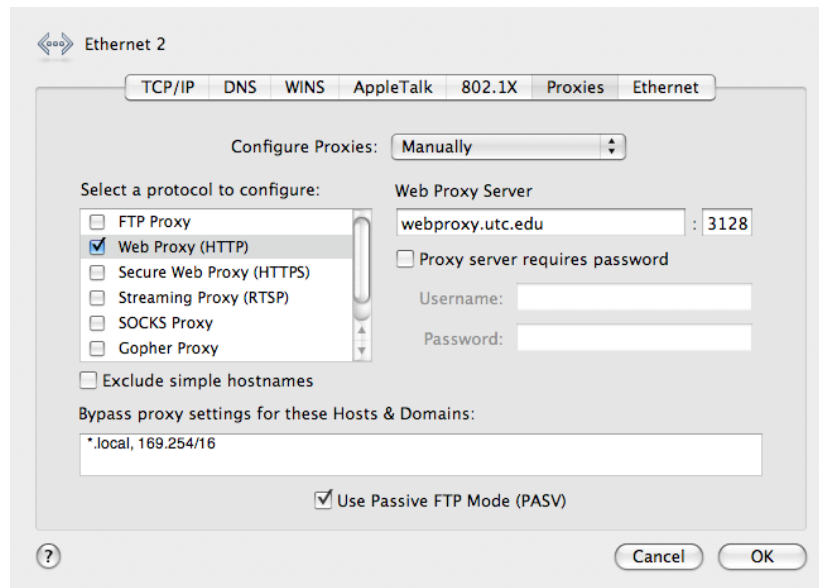
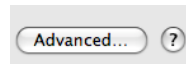
Run Firefox and select Preferences. Click on Advanced followed by Network and then Settings. Check "Manual proxy settings" and enter "webproxy.utc.edu" and "3128"





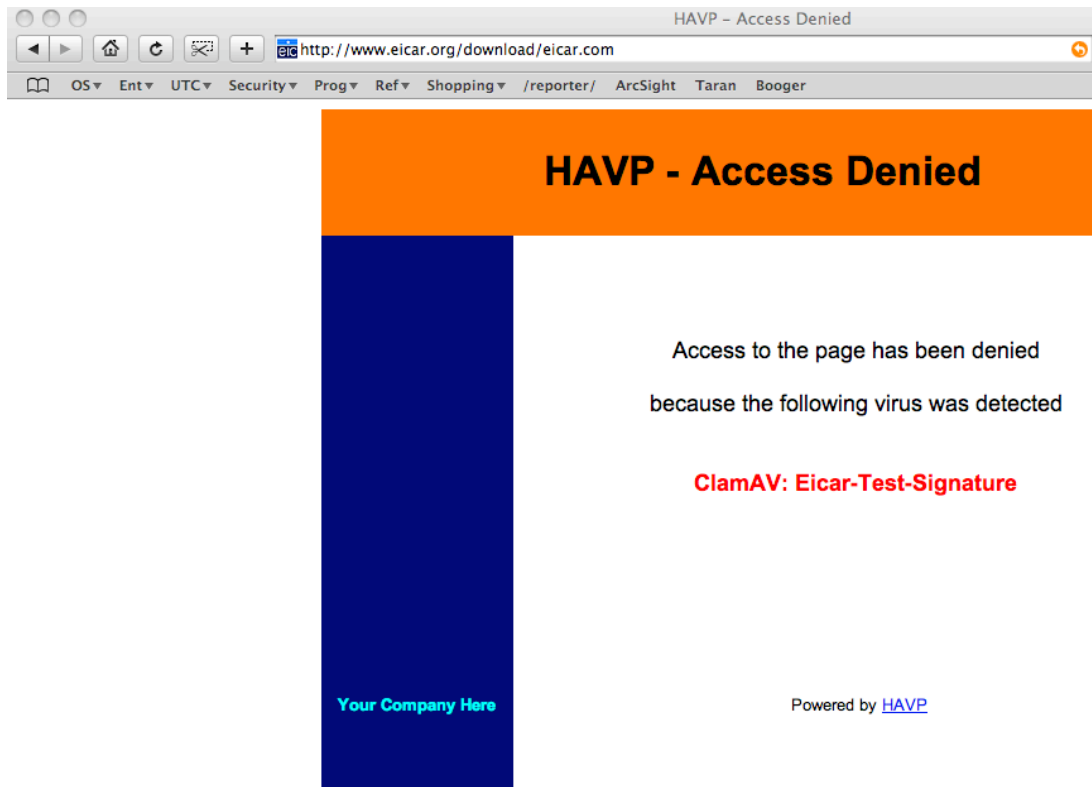
To Configure Safari

Select System Preferences from the Apple Menu. Click on Network followed by the Advanced button. Click on Proxies and enable the Web Proxy checkbox. Enter "webproxy.utc.edu" and "3128"
